

Faerie Pocket Heart Hanger



Supplies

Pattern paper	Double sided tape	Lace
*Ribbon	*Tinsel Stems	Paper Whimsy Fairies
Embellishments	Distress Ink	Buttons
*Wire	Old Book text	Ephemera
Eyelets	Matte Photo Paper	Glue Gun
White Glitter	Heart Doily	Digi Sheet 204

*You may create your hanger from tinsel stems, wire, or ribbon.

1. Print out Paper Whimsy Hybrid backgrounds. I used Damask 05 Jpg, Damask 06 Jpg, Damask 07 Jpg, and Damask 08 Jpg. You will find them in the shop here:

2. Trace out hearts using the template provided. You will need two layers.
3. Place two heart pieces back to back and glue together. You may use double sided tape (my preference) or a glue gun.
4. Cut one more heart (roughly in half) so it will fit as a pocket across the front.
5. Using Distress ink grunge up the edges of all the heart pieces.
6. Adhere lace across the top edge, add buttons and embellishments.
7. Tape sides of pocket with double-sided tape and add to the front of the heart.
8. Set eyelets on the top of the heart spacing evenly for hanging.
9. Run wire, tinsel stems or ribbon through the eyelet hole and tie. Add buttons or beads if you wish.

10. Print out Digi Sheet 204 and cut the large heart and words out. Add word to front of paper pocket.
11. Tuck Paper Whimsy image, Digi Sheet 204 heart and doily into pocket. You may use adhesive on the back if you wish.

Variations:

Use various Paper Whimsy images, tags and tuck inside the pocket.

The hanger is optional. This project would make a sweet handmade card also.
