

Gothic Arch Book Tutorial



Supplies:

Paper Whimsy Images
Eyelet setter
Buttons
Scallop Punch (optional)

Pattern Papers
Ribbon
Embellishments
Old Book Text or Music

Distress Ink
Mini Brads
Distress Ink
Double-Sided Tape

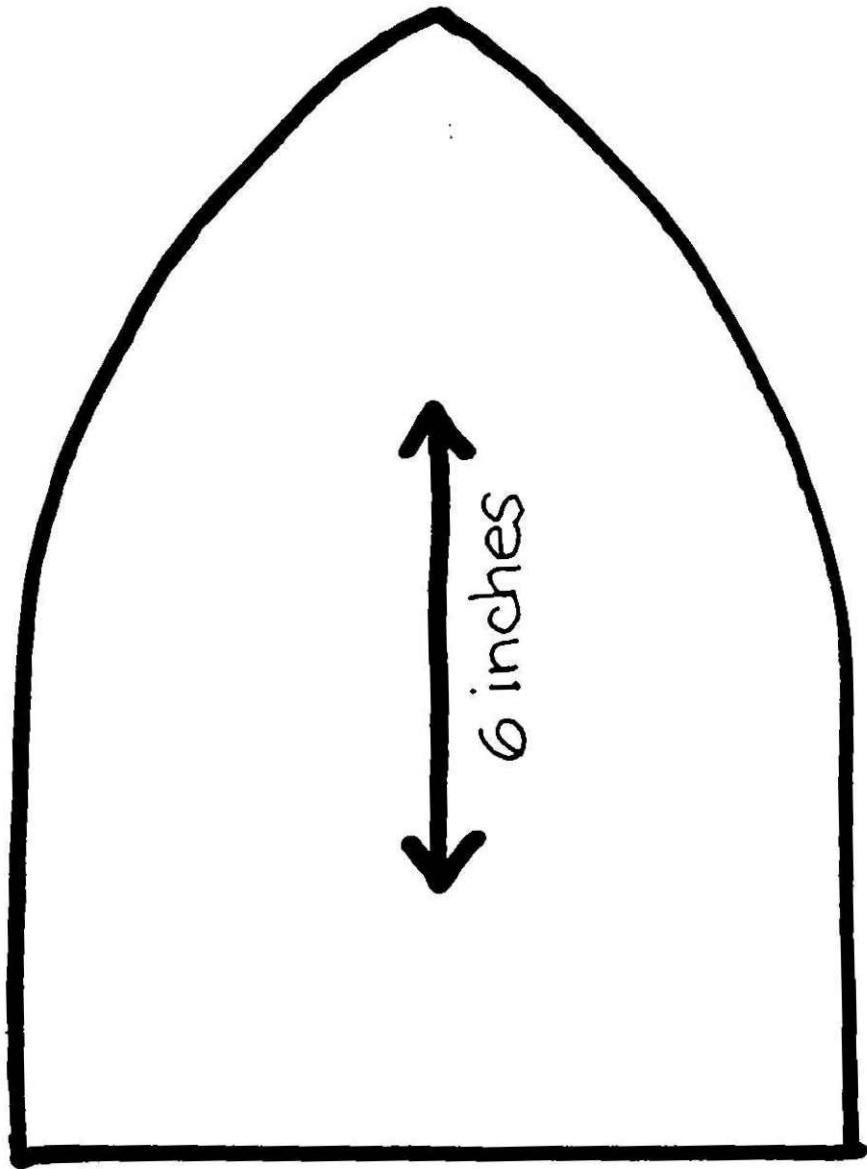

Technique:

1. Trace Gothic arch pattern (at the end of this tutorial) on to various heavy cardstock and cut out. I wrote on the back of each arch "back" so my arches would match up better when they are put into the book form. The book contains 8 separate arches that have been placed together. It is possible to add more arches for a chunky arch book.
2. Collage each Gothic arch using various pattern papers, Paper Whimsy images, ephemera, ribbon, buttons, or prima flowers. Add words from Digi Sheet 237.
3. Using double-sided tape place arches back to back and glue together. Distress the edges of each arch using distress ink and set aside to dry.
4. Mark holes on each arch (two holes each) and set eyelets.
5. Align book and thread thin ribbon through eyelet holes. Tie ribbon in bows. You can embellish the ribbon with charms if you wish.
